COVID-19 Relief: A 6-Month Snapshot

Between March and August 2020, The Children's Cabinet:

Distributed \$99,735 to assist families with Rent, Utilities, and Transportation

Provided **1,397 Food and Hygiene Baskets**, many delivered directly to homes

Conducted **1,787 Free Family Counseling Sessions**, telehealth and in-person



Presented Virtual Classes and Trainings attended by 204 Parents and 1,060 Child Care Providers

Had **100% Students Attending and Staying Connected** at our Redfield Academy On-Site High School




