Opportunities to support children and their families.





#### **Redfield Academy On-Site High School**

A successful alternative high school for students grade 9-12 who are two or more semesters behind and often considered 'vanished' by WCSD. Our teachers and case managers support students academically and personally as they re-engage, recover credits, and earn a diploma. Students and their families also receive wraparound services including food/hygiene boxes, work experience training, and family counseling.

\$8,000 supports one student for a year Impact: 50-60 students enrolled each school year



#### **Wraparound Case Management**

Every child and family who contacts The Children's Cabinet is offered wraparound support through our dedicated case managers. Case managers work with each family to assess unmet needs, establish customized family-centered goals, and connect them with programs and resources specifically chosen to meet their goals.

\$55,000 supports a case manager for one year *Impact:* Case managers support approximately 60 families per year.



#### **Children's Cabinet Market**

All clients have access to our food and hygiene pantries to ensure their basic needs are met. We provide Family Food Bags on a weekly basis, delivered door-to-door when needed. Financial donations help us supplement our inventory of canned goods with dairy, meat, produce, and grains. \$3.84 provides a full day of nutritious meals for a child. More and more families are having a difficult time meeting their basic needs as costs rise and COVID-19 emergency support comes to an end.

\$10,000 provides food and hygiene products to over 400 families each month



### **Family Counseling**

The Children's Cabinet is the only non-profit organization in northern Nevada that consistently provides free family counseling services. Our licensed mental health professionals help families improve their communication, find better ways to cope with difficulties as they arise, and strengthen their relationships.

\$70,000 supports a licensed therapist \$1,500 provides counseling, from start to finish, for a family Impact: over 200 families served annually



#### Safe Place and Street Outreach

The Children's Cabinet protects youth who are homeless, neglected, or find themselves in a threatening situation. Teens can ask for help through our 24-hour hotline (1-800-536-4588) or network of local businesses that act as Safe Place walk-up sites. We respond immediately- with case management, counseling, referral services, and emergency shelter, when needed. Our focus is always on keeping youth safe, ensuring a secure living arrangement, and reuniting families.

\$2,500 covers food, clothing, hygiene and other emergency outreach supplies for one month

*Impact:* Over 10,000 youth via street and school outreach, directly assisting 100 youth annually to find a Safe Place
