Families supported in finding quality child care that meets their needs.

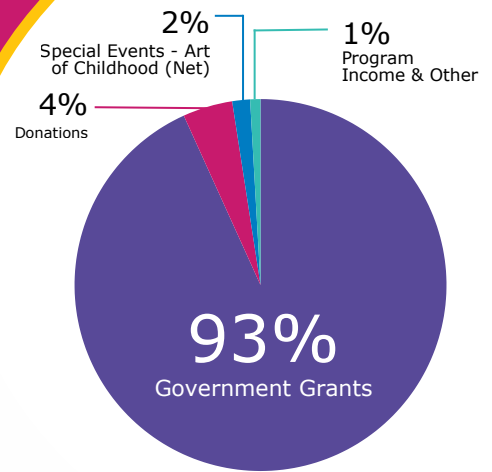

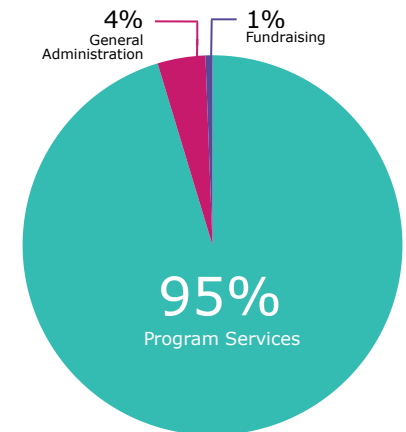
