The COVID-19 coronavirus pandemic of 2020 is an unprecedented public health challenge. The Nevada Department of Education, Office of Early Learning and Development and The Children's Cabinet want to support providers in responding to and recovering from this crisis. We have partnered with the Institute for Childhood Preparedness to give early learning providers **free** access to online training courses based on the latest scientific information.

These online courses are **Nevada-Registry approved** and led by expert instructors with backgrounds in public health, environmental health, pandemic preparedness, mental and behavioral health, food safety, and emergency preparedness. Online course participants will learn from a mix of slides, graphics, resources, videos, interviews, and real-world scenarios. You will receive a certificate of completion at the end of each course.

- The Domestic Violence course is 30 minutes long and the Hot Cars course is 45 minutes long. The Nevada Registry does not provide approval for courses under 1 hour; however, these two courses are still available on the website for you to take.
