

Expulsion and Suspension Prevention Request for Approval of Alternative Training Materials

Per current policy (PT 04-19), when a provider has already established a positive discipline model for staff in their child care center(s), they must receive approval from the Child Care and Development Program (CCDP) to use this model as an alternative to the required TACSEI training for the purpose of expulsion and suspension prevention.
